1995 JORDAN LAKE SNAPSHOT

Regular water testing continued, with the 1995 average summer water clarity at 12 feet (very good).

Average summer water temperature was up to 77.3 degrees Fahrenheit.

Total phosphorus testing was not done this year for reasons unknown.

The chlorophyll-a average level remained low at 2.0 micrograms/ liter.





1996 JORDAN LAKE SNAPSHOT

The average summer water clarity rose to 15.5 feet, which is very good clarity.

The average summer water temperature went down slightly to 73.3 degrees Fahrenheit.

Total phosphorus testing was done in 1996, with the summer average scoring at 37.6 micrograms/liter, which is the highest level since samples have been taken and is in the poor fair category.

The chlorophyll-a average was low at 4.5 micrograms/liter.
