Fur Drive built over natural runoff point. Study done in 1996 by several agencies seems to support this issue. Decision in 1996 was to not to take any action.

Much discussion about returning to normal wake rules and the erosion effects. Jackson Township owns the ordinance. JLRPD board will make a recommendation to the Township at a later date.
