# LAKE FACTS AS OF June 5, 2023 by Mike Backus

## **Water Level**

When the ice went out in Spring, the lake level was up from the last reading in late Fall. How much? I have no idea because I cannot measure from one year to the next when the lake is frozen. Since my pier measurement device was installed on April 14<sup>th</sup>, the lake level has gone down 3". It is my view we are still some 6-9" above normal but the worst is over.

## **Water Clarity**

I have been able to do clarity and temp monitoring 4 times thus far since the ice went off. The best clarity was 25' on May 7<sup>th</sup>. The warmest surfaced temp was 76.6degrees on 6/3. The floating green stuff on the surface is tree pollen soaking up the chlorophyll and will dissipate with winds and waves.

#### Rain

It was a little wet in early Spring BUT very dry since then! Since March 7<sup>th</sup> the lake area has had 7.5" of rain.

# Wild Life

One or more White Pelicans were spotted on Jordan and a few other lakes in the area. The big flock (some 200) stopped again this March by the Cove restaurant off Hy 23 in April. They stay for 2-3 weeks and are fun and beautiful to watch.

# **Wake Violations**

Yes, there have been more Wake Violations than normal this Spring. No Wake before 11:00am and No Wake after 5:30pm. It is a Town of Jackson Ordinance that we have to help enforce. **IF YOU SEE SOMETHING –SAY SOMETHING!**
