The lake had full ice on January 15, 2024, and no ice on March 6, 2024.Both dates were only days away from being records dating back to 1970.

## Lake Clarity

Keifer Sroka took it upon himself, days after the ice left our lake, to do a Clarity reading. He documented that he got a reading of 35' (a record for us) only because the device could not go deeper! Our summer average is about 15-18'.

## <u>Rain</u>

Since April 6<sup>th</sup>, the lake area has received 9.81" of rain. Moisture we did not get from snow we are getting from Spring rains.

## Lake Water Level

Measurement of our lake water level started on May 19<sup>th</sup>. The Spring rains have increased our lake level by5" as of this date.
