

LAKE FACTS AS OF JUNE 6, 2026

Lake Level

The large irrigation booms in farm fields started operating in late May. Not a good sign for our lake level! April was very wet delaying when farmers could get into their fields. May was very dry (less than 2" of rain) so they started irrigating. Our lake level is down 4.5" since April 17th.

Boat Landing

Adams Park Dept maintenance (grass cutting/dead tree removal and stocking launch tickets) has been pretty good so far this season. I had time to refresh the appearance of our District sign early this Spring.

Water Clarity

The lake has been monitored for clarity and temps three times thus far. Early Spring clarity has not been up to the normal levels and is of some concern. I got reading of 9'-14' vs what I would consider normal at 18'-23'. Not sure if it is tree pollen, lake turnover or something new. I will call for help from our Lake Specialist in Adams if it continues.
